Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs) are chemicals that remain intact in the environment for long periods, become widely distributed geographically, accumulate in the fatty tissue of humans and wildlife, and have adverse effects on human health or to the environment.

The European Union Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 aligns Community legislation with the provisions laid down in the international agreements on POPs. The Regulation goes beyond these provisions, for instance regarding the disposal of wastes containing POPs. The Regulation is legally binding and directly applicable in all EU Member States and implements the obligations of the Stockholm Convention.

Weidmüller constantly monitors this legislation and its amendments in order to ensure the conformity of the products concerned.

In addition, the disposal of affected products complies with waste disposal regulations, such as strict separation and correct labelling. We are in close contact with our disposal partners and of course use the electronic verification procedure in order to ensure compliance with waste disposal regulations.
