Depending on the definition, the substance group of PFAS comprises several thousand individual substance compounds. Due to our large number of applications and products, these may also contain small amounts of individual substances that are not regulated and fall into the PFAS group. Currently, there are many plans worldwide to regulate entire groups of PFAS or individual substances of the group for specific applications with different requirements and derogations.

We are following these developments very closely and as soon as individual legislations come into force, we will evaluate them. We are constantly working on compliance with substance-related legislation and are reviewing the possibility of substitution.

PFOA, PFOS, their salts and related compounds, are already subject to specific regulatory restrictions in Europe and other countries. For these substances, please note our statements on REACH and the POP Regulation.

The electrotechnical industry must provide information on various guidelines of the purchased products and product parts between the members of the supply chain. Please understand that we do not provide product-specific declarations beyond our general information or statement.
